Be Free Young Carers is committed to a safe and caring environment for young carers, employees and volunteers. This code of conduct outlines the expectations for all those involved in our young carer activities.

Be Respectful

- Be respectful of one another. Treat people with dignity and courtesy at all times;
- Be respectful of the ideas and feelings of others;
- Be kind to other young carers and help each other out; bullying will not be tolerated;
- Respect our staff and volunteers by listening and following along when you are asked to do something;
- Be respectful of the environment, equipment and materials.

Be Cooperative

- By talking and listening to others respectfully;
- By working together;
- Ask for help if and when you need it.

Be Safe

- Be aware of keeping each other safe at all times;
- Be patient with others and refrain from any behaviour or comments, which are profane, insulting, harassing, sexist, racist, abusive, disrespectful or otherwise offensive;
- Physical aggression will not be tolerated;
- Be aware that Under NO circumstances are alcoholic drinks, or smoking allowed on trips and activities;
- Swearing and inappropriate language will not be tolerated and may result in you being excluded from future trips.
